The primary responsibilities of this position is to facilitate the development of strategic approaches for innovation in learning through the use of technology in the curriculum, This professional will maintain awareness of best practices, emerging technologies and new potentials, while supporting users in a multi-platform environment.

The Ed-Tech Coach facilitates the strategic implementation of custom-fit tools for innovation, as aligned to the ISTE standards for teachers, with Google Suite for Education certification as a foundation for all.

- Implement a strategic plan for full capacity of Faculty in frameworks.
- Coordinating Computer Lab for integration of tech in curriculum.
- Managing MAP testing administration.
- Advocate for Faculty needs to ensure implementation of frameworks.
- Consider the alignment of the frameworks to the School's mission and values and continually monitor the implementation in service of student learning.
- Lead the implementation of active learning spaces.

The Ed-Tech Coach collaborates to support Faculty's ongoing growth through tiered services: the ANS Coaching platform with interactive resources for ongoing professional learning and job role training, divisional & team-based workshops and responsive sessions, and paired support in the classroom & virtually for teachers.
